| 02 | Janesville WI | 11:31 AM – undetermined | 2 goats died, 3 sheep escaped |
| 02 | Kirkwood NY | 2:00 PM – under investigation | 5 horses led to safety |
| 04 | Surry County NC | 8:45 AM – undetermined | 20,000 3-week old chickens, 1 may have survived |
| 04 | Memphis TN | 9:40 PM – appeared to be electrical | 19 horses died |
| 06 | Houston TX | 2 show sheep were killed when the trailer they were being hauled in caught fire, possibly from a carelessly tossed lit cigarette . A ram was saved. | |
| 09 | Cape Cod Animal Hospital MA | 8:00 PM – under investigation | 3 cats and 1 dog died, 12 dogs were saved |
| 11 | Red Hill Farm, Leesburg VA | Morning – faulty refrigerator | 17 dogs, including 10 puppies, and 3 horses died. 60 dogs survived |
| 20 | West Reading UK | 11:05 PM – electrical fault | 5 horses died, 3 horses rescued |
